(1925-1984)



Harold H. Hines Jr. served the insurance and risk management community for nearly 30 years. At the time of his death, he was president and chief executive officer of Rollins Burdick Hunter Co., now part of Aon. Mr. Hines also was a director and executive vice president of the parent company. Prior to that, he was president of Ryan Insurance Group, which merged with Combined International Corp. in 1982 and was later named Aon.

During the previous 12 years, Mr. Hines was with Marsh & McLennan Inc., where he served as president from 1978 to 1980.

Mr. Hines earned a bachelors degree in economics from Yale University.

Mr. Hines was a scholar who always questioned conventional wisdom, speculated on the future and developed long-range plans. He also generously gave his time to professional organizations and community work.
